SCHOOL OPERATIONS – TUESDAY 7th DECEMBER

Tacoma Public School will be OPERATIONAL on this day, although there will be a small disruption to our classes. We will continue to cohort the school into K-2 and 3-6 year groups. However, as some teachers will be absent, your child may not have their usual teacher for the day.

STEP-UP AFTERNOONS

Students will have the opportunity to meet the teachers and visit possible 2022 classrooms. Today was our first day, we will have our next one on Wednesday. As we have many composites, due to being a small school, your child will most likely visit two classrooms as a transition program. For example, if your child is in Year 3 next year, they will visit Balba and Murgu for a session. Transition programs aim to prepare our students for next year's classrooms and teachers to reduce worry and allow them to develop relationships. We are very fortunate in our school as the students know many of the teachers and staff across the school, which also helps.

CLASSES 2022

We are looking at classes for 2022 and will have 8 classes again. As the Department enrolment policy ensures we enrol new students in our catchment area, we never know who may turn up after school holidays. We have to be very flexible in our planning. Teachers put hours and hours of thought and discussion into where your child is placed.
