PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Tacoma Families,

Welcome to Week 8 – only one month of school remaining!

It has once again been a busy fortnight at Tacoma Public School and we continue to be explicitly teaching at students' individual level in reading, writing and numeracy. I want to thank our teachers and SLSOs for working tirelessly and flexibly with your children.

THANK YOU to you all for dressing your children in full school uniforms. There has been a big improvement in this area and we are very appreciative.

Another thanks for packing healthier lunch boxes! We have noticed an improvement overall, and your children will thank you, long term.

SUPPORT FROM HOME

One thing I have noticed since the return to school is the lack of basic concept retention in many of our students. I cannot emphasize enough that your child's education is a partnership between home and school. Those students who are thriving at school in their learning are working hard at school AS WELL AS at home. This means home reading every week night, practising sight words, multiplication tables and mathematical concepts such as double numbers, mental computation.



It is a combined responsibility of the school and parent/carer for academic progress. We will be sending age appropriate holiday work to revise in the coming holidays. It will not be new learning. It will be consolidating concepts that are vital for your child to be ready for the year 2022.

Whilst we do not expect parents to be doing hours every day, we do expect a 10-15 minute dedicated

session 2 or 3 times a week to save loss of learning and pushing concepts from short term to long term memory.

We will appreciate this partnership very much. Your child will thrive academically – it makes a real difference to their life ahead.



REMEMBERANCE DAY 2021

Congratulations to our captains, Tommy and Finn for running a beautifully sincere school ceremony for us all. All the students were overwhelmingly respectful – the two minute silence was just that. CLASSES 2022/STEP-UP TRANSITION

We are in the process of looking at classes for 2022. Due to the NSW DoE new policy, we have had to say no to many families wanting to come to our amazing school. However, we will retain 8 classes in 2022. Classroom teachers and classes are being determined over the next fortnight. Due to our numbers in each grade, we will have almost all composite classes. This is always the case in smaller schools and our teachers are well-equipped to deliver quality, explicit programs to the level/stage your child is at. Teachers put hours and hours of thought and discussion into where your child is placed.

We do take into consideration their friend choice (all students wrote a friend list today) as well as social, emotional and academic needs. Every child will be with at least one friend choice and a new class is always a lovely opportunity to expand their friendship group.

All our students will be visiting possible 2022 classrooms as part of our STEP-UP transition program. Due to the composite classes, your child may visit two classrooms/teachers in the program. For example, if your child is in Year 1 next year, they will visit Bamayi and Banal for a session. Transition programs aim to prepare our students for next year's classrooms and teachers to reduce worry and allow them to develop relationships. We are very fortunate in our school as the students know many of the teachers and staff across the school, which also helps. Our first session will be in Week 10.

HAPPY SPIRITS 2022

We are LOVING meeting our littlest Happy Spirits who are getting ready for Tacoma in 2022! We have loved playing together. many thanks to Mrs Fletcher, Mrs Nicholson and Mr Kirk for their planning and organisation as well as the SLSOs who have helped on these mornings.

RAPID ANTIGEN HOME TESTS (RAHT)

Last week, the NSW DoE released information about the RAPID ANTIGEN HOME TEST for Covid-19.

The school will NOT be administering these.

They are for families to use at home if the school has another positive Covid-19 case. For those students/staff who are close contacts, families will be given a RAHT to at home to reduce the amount of time missed at school. Parents/carers may test their children on Day 8 and allowed to come back to school if negative (rather than Day 15).

Parents/carers will receive an labelled envelope if your child is receiving an end of year award. Following school tradition, your child's name will not be on the invite to keep the surprise, just the date and time.

The invitations will be given to the youngest child in the family, regardless of who is receiving the award.
