#### **NEW EQUIPMENT**

We LOVE our new playground equipment! Thank you to the wonderful P&C who jointly funded this great addition to our playground. We have been waiting for the ground to be less wet to be able to get a truck in to deliver the soft fall pine bark.

#### ATTENDANCE

Whilst thankful to those parents keeping sick children at home, I ask you to send your WELL children to school. We are trying to get our students back into a school routine and developing behaviours that support their learning, such as being attentive, listening for longer periods of time and focusing on the learning. These learning behaviours develop best when students are at school day after day.

Currently our attendance:

31.1% of our school attend school 90% or more. 18.9% of our school attend 85-90% of the time.

49.8% of our school attend below 85% of the time.

Our goal, by the end of the year is to have 78% (34% increase) of our students here more than 90% of the time.

Our children are at SIGNIFICANT RISK if their attendance is below 90%. In Kindergarten and Year 1, 10% absence can leave a child struggling to read proficiently by the end of Year 3. By Stage 3, it becomes a key predictor that a student may drop out of high school.

Please make a BIG effort this term to get your child/children to school.

### School Travel Term 4 2022

2023 school travel applications are now open

Applications for student travel in 2023 open from Monday 10 October 2022.

Students who need a School Opal card or travel pass for 2023 can apply now. A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for the first time, or if they are requesting an additional travel entitlement as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who change address, school, campus location, have repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should renew or update their details before the end of term 4. This will ensure that schools can endorse applications, and entitlements remain valid for the start of the 2023 school year. School Opal card holders will have the changes applied to their existing card.

If a student's distance eligibility has changed based on their grade (i.e. grade two to grade three), the system will automatically update their entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new eligibility criteria, we will send an expiry notification via email.
